Years 3 - 6:

- Pencil case, including pencils, erasers, ruler, colouring pencils
- Parker Vector Fountain Pen or Left handed Fountain Pen
- Washable blue ink cartridges
(available to buy from school)

- Blazers should be worn every day, to and from school.
- Hair clips and bands should be plain in style and only navy blue or white.
- Hairstyles should be simple and conservative and should not be across eyes.
- Long hair must be tied back.
- No gel or other hair preparations should be worn.
- No nail varnish / Temporary tattoos.
- We are aware that some jewellery items have a religious or personal significance and we are grateful to parents for ensuring that these items are not worn in school.
- A small navy or black watch may be worn in Years 3-6.
- Ears can be singularly pierced. No double piercings please.
- Earrings can be worn, but they must be either:
 - - Clear plastic
 - - No more than 2-3mm studs.

No stones or hoops can be worn and if children arrive wearing earrings other than those regulated, they will be asked to remove them and we will send them home in an envelope.
- Earrings must be covered by parents ready for all PE activities. Micropore surgical tape is suitable for this. Any earrings not taped will have to be removed by the child.
- Smart watches, including Fitbits, with access to internet etc are also not allowed in school unless they are left in the office, in the same way that phones are.

Please make sure that all school uniform items are clearly labelled with your child's name.
